

### DSRSD charts path for the future





### Cover up this summer 🌊




DSRSD customers can get \$100 to install a pool cover through a rebate from [Zone 7 Water Agency](#).

Avoid putting fats, oils, or grease from your daily dinners and summer cookouts down the drain.


**Why it matters:** This can cause expensive issues with your home's plumbing and the public sewer system.
